### **Directions for Use**

- Floor must be clear of dirt, stains and oil. Remove any dust present by damp mopping, using minimum amount of water, and allow to dry.
- Apply one coat of ***PREMIUM GLOSS*** using a clean mop, and allow to dry.
- When dry, polish/buff with a floor machine to a shine.
- If necessary, apply a second coat, allow to dry and buff again.
- Regular damp mopping of the floor is to be carried out using a mild detergent. Alternatively, machine buff/polish with pads to remove surface dirt.

Note: This product is designed for hard wooden surfaces only. Solvent content will attack vinyl, stone and rubber floor surfaces.

### **Precautions**

As with most chemical products, avoid ingestion and eye contact. If ingested, dilute by drinking water and seek medical help. If product enters eyes, flush thoroughly with water and seek medical help.
